My parents will be informed that my place at breakfast club could be at risk if my behavior does not improve.</p> <p>If further similar incidents occur I will be not be able to attend breakfast club for the remainder of that week.</p> <p>If further similar incidents occur I will be excluded from breakfast club</p>
