

Lunchtime Playground Rules



You must do what the adults on duty tells you.

Zone A (main playground) is a supervised area for all children, the equipment must stay in that area only.

Zone B (seated area opposite shelter on main playground) is the Quiet Zone – no outdoor play equipment should be brought into this area.

All large balls can only be used in Zone D (the All Weather). There is a daily rota for different year groups.

Zone C (clamber stack) is a supervised area, no equipment to be brought in to that area.

When chalk is available draw pictures only, no words. Draw only on the playground not the walls.

All equipment must be put away by 1:05pm when the whistle sounds.

Help lunchtime monitors to make sure that all balls and equipment are put away carefully and not kicked.

Once outside you must not re-enter the building without adult permission.

When the whistle first blows you must stand still. On the second whistle you

WALK into your lines.

You must not bring your own balls to school or take the school's balls home.

Lunch Hall Rules



You must do what the adult on duty tells you.

Only touch your own food

Clear away your own rubbish and pick up anything you drop.

Only leave the hall when you have finished eating and leave sensibly without running/walking

Use a sensible voice.

Walk in the hall.

Food must not be thrown.

Put your hand up if you need the attention of a lunchtime supervisor.

When finding a seat; fill up the empty spaces first.

Be kind and sensible at all times.

Remember to say please and thank you.

Be mindful of the displays in the hall and try not to touch or lean on them.

Do not remove food from the hall.
